Horse care for horses includes cleaning the barn, paddock, or pasture at least once daily, feeding twice daily, plus a nightly 1/2 scoop of balanced vitamin and mineral feed, bi-monthly rotation worming, basic first-aid supplies, and biological fly control. Vet care, shoeing or vet appointments are scheduled as a day's training ride or as noted below.

Policies

Cancellations and Make-ups - Please give as much notice as possible when you are cancelling. Missed monthly lessons must be made up within two weeks during a group riding time. Missed training rides for weather or illness will be refunded at the beginning of the subsequent month's accounting.

Winter Hours - Horses need to be finished working, as well as cool and dry enough to blanket, before putting away. We have lights for evening riding, but not jumping.

Rainy-Day Hot-Day Lessons - On days when it is too wet or too hot to ride, we will have instructional activities in place of riding for club and monthly riders. If I am here training or teaching, no refund will be offered for hot or rainy days.
